Biography

KARO LYNN is a German indie-pop artist with a signature, richly deep voice that captivates listeners, adding a haunting depth to her atmospheric sound and reflective lyricism. Known for blending introspective ballads with catchy, groove-driven pop, her music combines raw emotion with a soundscape that resonates deeply. Since her debut, Karo has released two albums, *Outgrow* (2020) and *a line in my skin* (2022) under *Strays Don't Sleep Records*, both showcasing her unique vocal timbre and evolving style. Her latest album marks a distinct evolution toward a richer, more layered sound, demonstrating her versatility as she ventures into genres and styles influenced by artists like Daughter, Ben Howard, and The National.

Karo's talent was recognized through her participation in PopCamp 2021, and in 2023, she emerged as the winner of the newcomer contest GameChanger, leading to a performance at the prestigious Hurricane Festival. Her growing popularity led to her first headlining band tour across Germany in 2023, followed by a solo tour in 2024. She also joined Jules Ahoi on tour this year, expanding her reach within the indie music scene.

With extensive radio play and media coverage across Germany, KARO LYNN is drawing a dedicated fanbase that connects with her unique vocal style and the immersive quality of her music. Coverage from outlets like Rolling Stone, SCHALL Magazin, and major radio stations (including MDR Kultur, Flux FM, and Deutschlandfunk Kultur) has further spotlighted her work.

Currently participating in the Bandpool development program, KARO LYNN is poised to refine her artistry further and reach new heights in the indie-pop landscape.
